



Installing Fonts on Windows

Note that there is more than one way to install a font, but here's this is the method I'd use.

Windows XP

1. Download the font. If it is zipped up, then unzip (extract) it.
2. Navigate to the unzipped font and right-click on it. Select *copy*.
3. Open Control Panel (*Start > Control Panel*) and open *Fonts*. You should see a list of fonts already installed on your computer.
4. Find an empty area of the windows containing the fonts and right-click. Select *paste*.
5. Close the *Fonts* window and you're done!

Windows Vista

1. Download the font. If it is zipped up, then unzip (extract) it.
2. Navigate to the unzipped font and right-click on it. Select *install*.
3. If prompted, you will need to enter the administrator password for the computer before the font is installed. That's it!
